

FAQs - CLEAN THE BAY DAY 2016

- Q1. Where are we cleaning?
A1. We will clean five zones along the shoreline and one team will clean base waterways (see CTBD Map):
Zone one: Tidemill Creek to Eagle Park
Zone two: Eagle Park to King Street Bridge
Zone three: Langley Marina to ACC Trail Footbridge
Zone four: ACC Trail Footbridge to the Bayview Towers
Zone five: Base waterways
Zone six: Bethel Park
- Q2. Which group will I be in?
A2. Volunteers have the opportunity to select a zone to work in. We may ask some people to move to other groups to ensure every area is covered.
- Q3. What should I bring?
A3. Please bring sunscreen, insect repellent, comfortable work clothes, and work gloves if you have them. We will provide the previously stated supplies for those that do not bring any, as well as trash bags and water.
- Q4. What time do I need to show up?
A4. All personnel need to show up at Eagle Park by 0830 so we can get everyone signed in and ready to go by 0900.
- Q5. Can I bring my children?
A5. Yes, **BUT** we will be working near the shoreline, possibly in some areas with uneven ground and we don't want anyone to get injured. Parents will be responsible for their children.
- Q6. Can I bring pets?
A6. No. Pets will not be allowed during the clean-up.
- Q7. What time will we be finished?
A7. The event will end at 1200. If you need to leave early, please let your zone leader know at the event.
- Q8. Do I have to pre-register?
A8. For planning purposes, we recommend that everyone preregisters. Sign-ups on the day of the event will be welcomed. To register, email ronald.best@us.af.mil.
- Q9. Can off-base personnel participate?
A9. Off-base personnel can participate with a military sponsor. You will have to escort them on base or meet them at the La Salle Gate Visitor Center to sign them

onto the base. Please ensure you personally know the person, as he/she is your full responsibility.

Q10. Where is Eagle Park and how do I get there?

A10. Eagle Park is on Nealy Ave across from the Bowling Center (See CTBD Map).

Q11. How do we get to the zone we are working on?

A11. All volunteers are to meet at Eagle Park by 0830 to sign-in and choose the zone of your choice. Buses will transport volunteers to and from each zone. Bethel Park (Zone 6) volunteers have the option to drive themselves. Directions will be provided on the day of the event.

Q12. Can I wear sandals?

Q12. No. Wear sturdy, comfortable work shoes. No open toed shoes allowed.
